

- 1. Always follow the instructions of Steinweg personnel and make sure you have read the site rules.
- 2. Make sure you wear the correct personal protective equipment.
- 3. When loading or unloading the trailer, always ensure that you are in a safe position outside the working area of the forklift truck.
- 4. Make sure you never walk past the forklift truck during loading / unloading!

The following applies to **loading docks**: Stay out of the trailer when a forklift is present in the trailer! When **loading sideways** the following applies: Always stay at least 1 meter outside the reach and turning circle of the forklift truck and make sure that you keep eye contact with the forklift truck driver!

- 5. Preparing the securing of the load may only start after approval of the forklift driver. Make sure that the forklift driver always sees you!
- 6. The moving of the pillars may only start after approval from the forklift driver. Make sure that the forklift driver always sees you!
- 7. Securing the load may only start after approval from the forklift driver and only after the loading has been completed. Please be aware that during loading, it is NOT secured!
- 8. When securing the load, never go to places where you can be hit by (falling) cargo or come into contact with the forklift truck and / or other traffic.
- 9. Be aware at all times of the fact that there is heavy work traffic at the terminal and that there is a risk of collision hazard and accidents occurring. The Steinweg work traffic always has priority over pedestrians and freight traffic.
- 10. Failure to follow these instructions and safety rules can result in a life-threatening danger! If the rules are not observed, you can be denied access to the terminal without your truck being loaded or unloaded.
